Friends of Friends Program is designed to provide solution focused and service based programming for clients who have faced homelessness, or as a result of poverty, need immediate outreach services. Our vision for Friends of Friends program is to help those who want to uplift themselves toward self-sufficiency with 6 months of individual case planning.

Friends of Friends Program

Clients have two options: You can go through our pre-designed phases 1, 2, and 3; or choose the My Phase option. My Phase allows an individual to choose personal goals they want to accomplish, and over the course of 6 months, Friends of Night People will help turn those goals into a reality.

How do I Join?

Meet with the Program Coordinator to see if the Friends of Friends Program is the right fit for you. After meeting with the program coordinator, clients will set a schedule to meet for a minimum of 2 hours a week for 6 months.

Where can I meet the Program Coordinator?

The Program Coordinator is available to meet with clients on-site at 394 Hudson Street. Walk-In hours are from 3pm-7pm Saturday - Wednesday.
